## **MORTUARY SCIENCE LICENSE EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS**

### **Non-Baccalaureate Option**

Applicants for Mortuary Science licenses are required to have completed not less than 60 semester hours or 90 quarter hours (with not less than a 2.0 average) of on-remedial college level courses at an accredited college or university, which shall include the following:

	<b>Subject</b>	<b>Minimum Hours</b>
(i)	Public speaking/communications	3 semester/3 quarter
(ii)	Psychology/death and dying/ Gerontology	6 semester/8 quarter
(iii)	Comparative religion or Ethnic/multi-cultural studies	3 semester/4 quarter

All required courses must be undergraduate courses numbered 100 Level or higher.

Applicants must also complete an \*accredited mortuary science program (with not less than 2.0 average).

**OR**

### **Baccalaureate Option**

Applicants for a Mortuary science license are required to have obtained a baccalaureate degree from an accredited institution. Applicants must also complete an \*accredited mortuary science program (with not less than a 2.0 average).
