Between Division and Chestnut Streets, Jeffrey Drive is a cul-de-sac off Leeson Street. Approximately 1/2 mile west of Cadillac Junior High and High Schools.

**Valley Home  
1915 Michigan Ave, Cadillac**



The Valley home has 12- Sharp NT-175u1 mono crystalline solar panels, 1-PV Powered 2000 Watt Extended Range Inverter, 1-PVP 1010 Inverter data monitoring system, and a Power-Fab Top of Pole Rack.

The 1.05 Kw system went online 7/2/2008. My six panel increase went into effect 4/3/2009. Bringing my total system to a 2.1 Kw. My system is installed on a small city lot and doesn't take up much space. I have reduced my electric usage to approximately 7 Kwh / day. This summer I have averaged 9 KWH / day production.
