**FINAL ORDER TO REVOKE FIRST MORTGAGE LICENSE**

I.  
FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On June 5, 2009, pursuant to MCL 445.1662, the Commissioner issued to Respondent a NOTICE OF INTENTION TO REVOKE FIRST MORTGAGE LICENSE ("Notice").
2. Said Notice, served on Respondent via certified mail, was received by Respondent on June 16, 2009, as evidenced by the signed certified mail Domestic Return Receipt.
3. Said Notice contained allegations that Respondent had violated the Mortgage

Brokers, Lenders, and Servicers Licensing Act, 1987 P.A. 173, as amended, MCL 445.1651 *et seq.* ("MBLSLA"), which warrant the revocation of Respondent's first mortgage license.


4. Said Notice further advised Respondent that failure to request a hearing within 20 days would result in the issuance of a final order revoking Respondent's first mortgage license.
5. Respondent failed to request a hearing within 20 days as required by statute.

**II.**  
**FINAL ORDER TO REVOKE FIRST MORTGAGE LICENSE  
AND SECOND MORTGAGE REGISTRATION**

**NOW THEREFORE**, based upon the factual findings set forth above and the files and records of OFIS, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:**

1. Respondent's first mortgage license, license no. FL-4190, issued pursuant to provisions of the MBLSLA, shall be and hereby is **REVOKED**.
