## REGION FIRE FIGHTER RE-TEST/CHALLENGE EXAMS

The Office of Fire Fighter Training has scheduled regional exam sites for individuals needing to **re-test** the Fire Fighter I, II, or I & II exams. To participate, a copy of the *Notification of Exam Results* letter received from the Office of Fire Fighter Training must be mailed or faxed to the appropriate address below. The individual's home address, daytime contact phone number, and test location requested **must be written on this letter** so that a confirmation letter can be mailed to the re-tester. Re-test students will be given priority over challengers in the event that the examination fills up. (NOTE: Re-testers must re-test the same level of exam which was taken originally. If your first test was a FF I & II - you must re-test at the FF I & II level. If you wish to test for FF I, you need to challenge the FF I exam – both written and practical.)

Individuals wanting to **challenge** the Fire Fighter exam for the first time must submit a *Challenger Test Application* (BFS-215) to the appropriate address below. A firefighter challenging the Fire Fighter II exam, **MUST** submit a copy of his/her Fire Fighter-I certificate with the application or it will be rejected. Challengers must be members of a Michigan fire department. (NOTE: If an individual failed a challenge exam in the past and is re-testing, this person must follow the directions for a re-tester above). Pre-service students needing to re-test the Fire Fighter exam must submit a letter from the Regional Training Center (RTC) where they originally took their training. This letter shall state that the RTC will provide any needed Personal Protective Equipment and cover the student for liability/injury during the re-test. The RTC letter must accompany *the Notification of Exam Results letter*.

All individuals who take the **practical** portion of any examination will be required to have current NFPA compliant turnout gear. This must include a helmet with face shield (not goggles), hood, turnout coat, bunker pants, boots, gloves, SCBA, and PASS alarm if an alarm is not engineered into the SCBA. The SCBA is not required if the individual is taking the Fire Fighter II examination. All individuals **MUST** bring photo ID (Michigan drivers license) to be admitted to any portion of the examination.
