Agenda Item #1—Call to Order

The July 16, 2009 MIOSHA Lifting and Digging Equipment Advisory Committee meeting was called to order by Co-Chair John Hartwell. Mr. Hartwell welcomed everyone to the meeting. The advisory committee members, MIOSHA staff, and visitors introduced themselves.

Agenda Item #2—Approval of Minutes from June 18 Meeting

A motion was made by Gary Jordan and seconded by Tim LaLonde to approve the minutes of the June 18, 2009 advisory committee meeting. **MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.**

Agenda Item #3—Review Draft #9 Dated June 18, 2009

The committee made additional changes to Rule 1008b as noted in Draft #10. There are several items that need to be discussed again at the next meeting:

- Discuss alternate language for trainee/apprentice supervision

Discussion of Rule 1008b(3) Certification by an accredited crane/derrick operator testing organization was tabled until the next meeting.

Mark LaClair suggested that qualifications for riggers and signalpersons should also be addressed by the committee. Several committee members agreed with this suggestion. The Construction Safety Standards Commission will need to approve these additional areas before the committee can address them. John Hartwell agreed to present this suggestion to the Commission when they meet in September.

Agenda Item #4—Public Comment

Mr. Tom Martin and Mr. Paul Johnson both had similar concerns regarding sending their employees to other states to work and having people from other states come to Michigan to work (portability of crane operator certifications).
