

**OH Part 478. Illumination
Compared With
29 C.F.R. 1910.265 Sawmills and 1910.261 Pulp, paper, and paperboard mills.**

Summary: OH Part 478. Illumination is identical to 29 C.F.R. 1910.265 Sawmills and 1910.261 Pulp, paper, and paperboard mills except for the following rule shown in the comparison.

- Illumination level generally.
- Illumination for sawmills.

The comparisons show only those provisions where MIOSHA rules are different than OSHA or where MIOSHA rules are not included in 29 C.F.R.

<p>R 325.51004 Illumination for sawmills. Rule 1. (a) to (d)**** (e) Fuel houses, bunkers, hoppers, and bins shall have adequate exits and lighting, and all necessary safety devices shall be provided and persons entering fuel houses, bunkers, hoppers, and bins shall use the safety devices. (f) Log dumps, booms, ponds, or storage areas used at night shall be illuminated in accordance with the requirements of American National Standard A11.1-1965 (R-1970) Standard Practice for Industrial Lighting, which is adopted by reference in subdivision (c) of this subrule.</p>	<p>Equivalent</p> <p>1910.265(c)(23)(iii) Exits, lighting, and safety devices. Fuel houses and bins shall have adequate exits and lighting, and all necessary safety devices shall be provided and shall be used by persons entering these structures</p> <p>No comparable OSHA provisions.</p>
