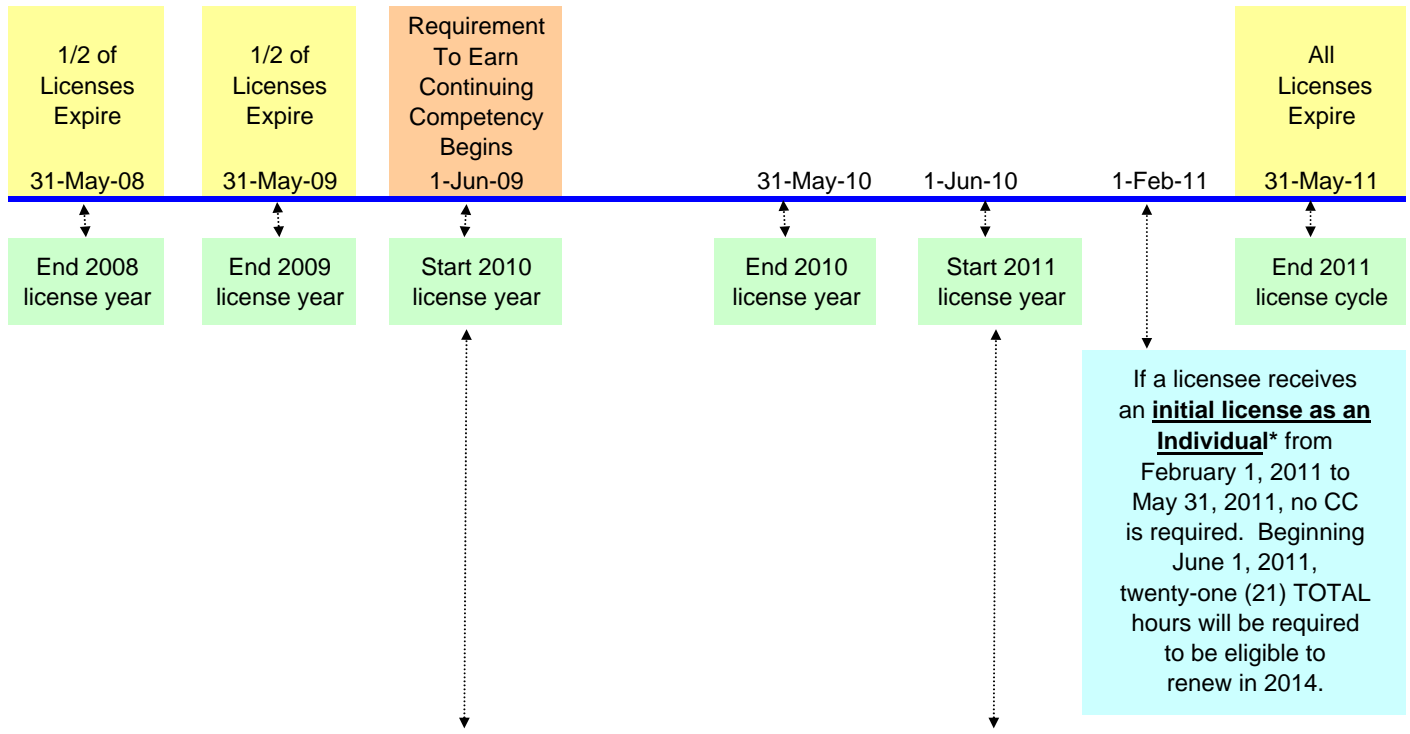


Individual Residential Builder and Individual Maintenance & Alteration Contractor Timeline for Continuing Competency



If a licensee receives an **initial license as an Individual*** from June 1, 2009 to May 31, 2010 -- Fourteen (14) TOTAL hours of CC must be completed by May 31, 2011 to be eligible to renew in 2011.

NOTE: Three (3) of the 14 hours must include 1 hour of codes, 1 hour of safety, and 1 hour relating to changes in construction and business management laws.

If a licensee receives an **initial license as an Individual*** from June 1, 2010 to January 31, 2011 -- Seven (7) TOTAL hours of CC must be completed by May 31, 2011 to be eligible to renew in 2011.

NOTE: Three (3) of the 7 hours must include 1 hour of codes, 1 hour of safety, and 1 hour relating to changes in construction and business management laws.

If a licensee receives an **initial license as an Individual*** by May 31, 2009 -- Three (3) TOTAL hours of CC must be completed by May 31, 2011 to be eligible to renew in 2011.

NOTE: The three (3) hours must include 1 hour of codes, 1 hour of safety, and 1 hour relating to changes in construction and business management laws.

***Initial license as an Individual** – The first license ever issued to a licensee as an individual residential builder or individual residential maintenance and alteration contractor. An "Individual" license is issued in the licensee's personal name and the license number will begin with "2101" or "2103".
