**Agenda Item #4 Continue Review of GI-33 Draft #3**

**Co-Chairperson Terry Monahan**

Co-Chairperson Terry Monahan began the review of GI-33 Draft #3. The advisory committee reviewed the entire draft and approved changes to the following sections:

- ❖ R 408.13301 Scope
- ❖ R 408.13306 Definitions; S to W
- ❖ R 408.13308 Hazard assessment and equipment selection
- ❖ R 408.13310 Employer's and employee's responsibilities
- ❖ R 408.13311 Face and eye protection; consensus standards
  - Terry Monahan compared ANSI Z87.1, 2010 vs. 2003; he reported that the 2010 version is written in a different style to be shorter but the provisions are the same.
  - John Brennan compared ANSI Z87.1, 2010 vs. 2003; he reported that industry is following the 2010 version.
    - Mr. Monahan and Mr. Brennan recommended to the advisory committee to adopt the ANSI Z87.1 - 2010 edition standard.
