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Agenda Item #2 Clarification of Instructions for PPE Advisory Committees **Dan Dykstra**

Mr. Dykstra clarified the guidelines. MIOSHA wants to emphasize that the intention is not to have all sections of all three standards be exactly the same. In fact, some sections should have more sub-rules than others on the exact same topic. The guidelines are:

- ❖ Keep all three standards
- ❖ Improve clarity, when needed
- ❖ Improve consistency, when needed.
- ❖ Avoid conflicting rules
- ❖ Update Consensus Standards to most current
- ❖ Needs Consistency
 - GI-33 R 408.13390(1) states 25 feet above the ground....
 - CS-6 R 408.40631(1) states 10 feet above the ground....
