1. CALL TO ORDER AND DETERMINATION OF QUORUM

Chairperson Pratt called the meeting to order at approximately 9:30 a.m. A quorum was determined present at that time.

2. APPROVAL OF AGENDA

3. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

4. DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Irvin announced that Tennison Barry retired effective September 30, 2010. He welcomed Kevin Kalakay as the new chief of the Mechanical Division.

Irvin also announced that Margie Hebden will be retiring effective January 1, 2011. Irvin thanked her for her hard work and dedication to the bureau.

Building, Residential, Rehabilitation and Energy codes are all at JCAR. 12 sessions days have been completed towards the required 15.

Irvin updated the commission regarding the registration as a plumbing inspector (Kevin Gaby) that was brought forward to the commission at the April meeting. Irvin stated that Mr. Gaby had 60 days from the date of his letter to appeal the commission's decision. Our bureau has not received a request for appeal and the time has expired. Therefore, the Final Action stands.

Irvin, Beth and Dan O'Donnell met with MEDC, DELEG, and industry representatives to discuss construction regulation of alternative energy installations.

Irvin had a meeting with a constituent group regarding hoop buildings in urban areas. Irvin indicated that in Act 230, hoop buildings may be exempt based on the agricultural exemption in the Act.

Irvin will be attending the ICC Final Action Hearings in Charlotte, NC on October 27-31, 2010. He is the only individual from the bureau attending.

The fall conference for COCM was held in Traverse City on September 27 through October 1, 2010 where Tennison Barry, Larry Lehman and Irvin Poke gave presentations. During the conference Bill Benoit was awarded the Building Inspector of the Year Award.

COCM and BCC are again planning a joint training to be held in January of 2011.



It is the recommendation of Bureau staff that the programs submitted pursuant to the provisions of Act 54 be approved by the Commission.

Explanatory notes to accompany BCC Approved Continuing Education Program List:

* Registrants holding one or more Inspector classifications are required to attend Technical and Specialty training to be eligible for reregistration at the end of the present code cycle. If that is successfully accomplished, there are no additional Technical or Specialty credits necessary to also become eligible for reregistration as either a Building Official and/or Plan Reviewer. A person who is registered **only** as a Building Official and/or Plan Reviewer **without any Inspector classification** will receive the listed Technical and/or Specialty credit towards reregistration qualification for attending this program.

Specialty approvals are granted for one of the four Inspector (trade) classifications. Inspectors receive credits **only** for attending programs associated with their trade; a Mechanical Inspector does not satisfy those requirements by attending a Building, Electrical or Plumbing program. Someone registered **only** as a Building Official and/or Plan Reviewer **without any Inspector classification** will receive credit for all Specialty programs attended, regardless of the trade(s).

Technical approvals are granted for programs addressing a specific code. Inspectors receive Technical credit **only** for programs addressing the code they enforce. Someone registered **only** as a Building Official and/or Plan Reviewer without any Inspector classification will receive credit for all Technical programs **in their** cycle which they attended, regardless of the trade.

** Programs approved for Plan Review credits satisfy unique requirements placed on Plan Reviewer registrants. Even though the title of an individual program may refer to a specific trade or code, all Plan Review program credits apply to any Plan Reviewer.

**** Credit for documented participation in/attendance at formal code change hearings conducted and reported by a nationally recognized code-promulgating organization will be recognized when the subject is a code enforced by the registrant. Credit is granted in one-hour increments and is divided between Technical and Specialty. The first hour is Technical, the second Specialty, the third Technical, the fourth Specialty, etc. Seven hours would be credited as four Technical and three Specialty, for example.

The following summary report of the performance evaluation of Menominee County provides the recommendation from the performance evaluation report submitted to the Commission, the County's response to the recommendation, and the Bureau's analysis of the County's response.

1. Recommendation

It is recommended that the County revise and update its Schedule of Fees to assure reasonable fees are being charged for plan review, inspections, appeals and other services in accordance with Section 22 of 1972 PA 230. The updated fee schedule shall be submitted to the Bureau.

Response/Analysis

On January 19, 2011, the County provided an updated Schedule of Fees for construction code services. The County formally adopted the updated Schedule of Fees on December 28, 2010, and it includes fees for the conduct of plan reviews and inspections, appeals and other construction code services being provided to the public. Therefore, it has been verified that the County has complied with Recommendation No. 1.

Recommendation: Based upon the verification that the County's corrective action has been completed, it is the recommendation of staff to close the performance evaluation file.
