SUBJECT: Research on Public Land Corners/Property Controlling Corners

Research on corners is required to be completed for each corner included in the State Survey and Remonumentation program. This office will use Section A of the Land Corner Recordation Certificate to verify completion of corner research.

All three portions (A, B and C) of the Land Corner Recordation Certificate must be completed in full and the County Representative should review the certificate for completeness prior to filing them with the Commission. Incomplete Land Corner Recordation Certificates will not be accepted by the Commission but will be returned to the County Representative to coordinate the satisfactory completion of the certificate with the monumentation surveyor.

NOTE: An incomplete Land Corner Recordation Certificate which is revised must be re-recorded with the county register of deeds. A county which has had a Land Corner Recordation Certificate(s) returned for completion will not receive final closeout for their grant contract nor the final 10 percent payment of the grant until all satisfactorily completed Land Corner Recordation Certificates have been re-recorded and returned to the Commission.
