## 1 Who Should Attend . . .

## 2 MIOSHA Training Institute

MIOSHA Consultation Education and Training (CET) Division and Macomb Community College (MCC) have developed the MIOSHA Training Institute (MTI) through a formal alliance.

The MIOSHA Training Institute introduced a certification program, effective October 1, 2007. This course is an MTI Level One course. The certification program offers participants an opportunity to be recognized for their educational efforts and increased technical expertise. Courses are offered throughout the state in sponsorship with other M-TEC<sup>SM</sup> facilities, community colleges, and safety and health organizations. This half day seminar course is designed for General Industry participants, (maintenance, safety and health professionals, and management personnel). This seminar familiarizes the participant with various types of common machinery and the related safety hazards. The course enables participants to recognize hazards such as those created by points of operations, rotating parts and flying chips, and provides options to achieve abatement.
