

POLICY 0240 Emergencies/Disasters

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Executive Branch Departments and Sub-units shall request assistance from the Department of Technology, Management and Budget (DTMB), Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Protection (CIP), Office of Infrastructure Protection (OIP), Central Control Unit regarding medical emergencies, hazardous material emergencies, fires, bomb threats, natural disasters and criminal activity occurring at DTMB-managed facilities in the City of Lansing and Windsor Township (Eaton County).

Executive Branch Departments and Sub-units located in DTMB-managed facilities outside of the City of Lansing and Windsor Township shall request assistance as directed from their prearranged emergency response personnel regarding medical emergencies, hazardous material emergencies, fires, bomb threats, natural disasters and criminal activity.

Legislative and Judicial Branch Departments shall request assistance from the Michigan State Police regarding medical emergencies, hazardous material emergencies, fires, bomb threats, natural disasters and criminal activity occurring at state-owned facilities in the City of Lansing.

In addition, the Michigan State Police, Emergency Management & Homeland Security Division will coordinate the response of all Executive Branch Departments and Sub-units in statewide emergency and/or disaster situations.
