**Law Enforcement Officer Selection, Employment, Training and License  
Maintenance Standards and Training Facilities**

All applicants for fully empowered state and local law enforcement officer positions who will be responsible for the prevention and detection of crime and the enforcement of the general criminal laws of this state shall meet minimum selection, employment, training and license maintenance standards established by the Michigan Commission on Law Enforcement Standards (MCOLES). In addition, Executive Branch Departments and Sub-units may use training facilities located in state or other buildings by following applicable procedures.
