POLICY 0930 Historic Preservation

Issued: January 1, 1994
Revised: April 12, 2012

Executive Branch Departments and Sub-units shall comply with applicable statutory and regulatory provisions and cooperate with the Michigan State Housing Development Authority (MSHDA) and the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) on:

- Preservation and/or reuse of historic state buildings determined to be surplus to the needs of the department.
- The preservation of objects and materials in their possession which have acquired importance through their age or association with people, places or events significant to Michigan history.
- Administration of programs using federal funds or requiring federal or state licenses or permits.
