

POLICY 1810 Permits

Environmental Requirements

Executive Branch Departments and Sub-units shall comply with applicable statutory and regulatory requirements, including, but not limited to, those governing:

- Disposal of used lead-acid batteries, used oils, solid waste, yard clippings or yard waste;
- Registration of releases from and claims concerning underground storage tanks which they own or operate;
- Performance of appropriate response activities pertaining to the release of a hazardous substances or threat of a release, and repair injury, destruction or loss to natural resources caused by the release or threat of a release;
- Generation, transportation and disposal of hazardous waste and non-hazardous liquid industrial wastes;
- Hazardous waste facilities, including the establishment of a hazardous waste limited storage facility or the conduct, management, maintenance or operation of such in Michigan;
- When purchasing materials in plastic containers of eight ounces or more shall insure that the containers are labeled to show the plastic resin used to produce them; and for any container (glass, metal, plastic bottles, cans, jars, etc.) connected to another container by a separate holding device, the holding device is constructed of plastic that is degradable and bears a distinguished symbol; and
- Construction and installation of equipment that requires air, water or waste permit.
