### **SUMMARY**

---

The Michigan Automated Fingerprint Identification System (AFIS) is a computerized system for electronically encoding, searching and matching tenprint, palm print and latent fingerprints. Currently, AFIS contains over 3.4 million fingerprint records in the Tenprint Database and over 55,000 unsolved latent fingerprints in the Latent Database. AFIS is maintained by the Michigan State Police (MSP), Automated Print Identification Section.
