



NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Caledonia Community Schools, Michigan, will receive proposals from qualified contractors for the Kraft Meadows Middle School Paving Project, located at 9230 Kraft Avenue, Caledonia, MI 49316.

General (Prime) Contractor bids are open to all qualified bidders. The Owner will enter into one contract with the successful General (Prime) Contractor. The contract of this work shall include all the work scope of the Excavating Contractor and Paving Contractor, including all coordination and scheduling between any subcontractors utilized by the General (Prime) Contractor. Prime Contractor may be either the Excavating Contractor or the Paving Contractor.

Note: Where "contractor" is referred to in these specifications, this shall be interpreted to refer to the General Contractor, unless noted otherwise.

Proposals must be mailed or delivered in person to Mr. Gary Delger, Caledonia Community Schools, 9753 Duncan Lake Ave., Caledonia, MI 49316. All proposals must be sealed in envelopes, plainly labeled "Kraft Meadows MS Repaving Project" and must be received prior to 1:00 P.M., local time, on Wednesday, May 30, 2007. This will be a public bid opening held in the Board Room at Duncan Lake Middle School immediately following the bid deadline. Evaluation of proposals and award will be at a later date; the successful contractor will receive a letter of intent prior to receipt of contract.

The Schedule of Work shall be as follows:

All bidders are required to furnish Bid Security in the amount of five (5%) percent of the Base Bid made payable to Caledonia Community Schools. Form of the security may be a bid bond, certified or cashiers check. This will be a guarantee that the bidder selected by Caledonia Community Schools will furnish the required PLM Bonds; failure to do so could mean forfeiture of the Bid Security.

All bidders must indicate, where shown on the Proposal Form, the cost of Performance and Labor and Material Payment Bonds covering 100% of the value of the Project. Do not include the cost of the Bonds in the Base Bid.



All bids shall be accompanied by a sworn statement disclosing any familial relationship that exists between the owner(s) or any employee of the bidder and any member of the Board of Education of the School District or the Superintendent of the School District. The Board of Education shall not accept a bid that does not include a sworn and notarized familial relationship disclosure statement.

Applicable Michigan use and sales tax apply to this project.

All bidders should note that this project REQUIRES prevailing wages.
