One lump-sum Bid is being solicited. All contractors shall comply with the Michigan Prevailing Wage Act. Bid proposals shall be accompanied by a satisfactory Bid Bond or Certified Check for five percent (5%) of the Base Bid Sum maximum proposal amount. Bidders shall agree not to withdraw Bid Proposal for a period of thirty (30) day after date for receipt of bids.

No pre-bid meetings are scheduled, but ASTI Environmental will conduct a pre-construction meeting to approve all methods and materials. Unless a written extension is obtained from the Owner, the project shall be substantially complete within 30 calendar days from Notice to Proceed and closed out within 45 days of Notice to Proceed.

As required by the State of Michigan, P.A. 232 of 2004, all Bids must be accompanied by a sworn and notarized statement disclosing any familial relationship that exists between the bidder and any member of the school board, schools superintendents, or chief executive.

Owner reserves the right to waive any irregularities in Bidding, to reject any or all proposals, or to accept a proposal and award contract, which in their opinion, serves the best interest of the Hartland Consolidated Schools.
