Your firm is invited to submit an offer under seal to Lakeshore Public Schools for complete asphalt playground replacement at three (3) schools: Stewart Elementary, Hollywood Elementary and Roosevelt Elementary before 2:00 p.m. local time on the 13th day of February, 2008. Bids are to be hand-delivered to the Central Business Office at the High School - Address Bids to Mr. Robert Burgess, Chief Financial Officer, Lakeshore Public Schools, 5771 South Cleveland Avenue, Stevensville, Michigan 49127. Bids will be opened and read publicly at that time. Late Bids will not be accepted.
- B. Project Description: Under the Base Bid this work shall consist of a complete asphalt playground removal and repairing including site grading, sand subbase, gravel and asphalt pavement. The scope of work will include the following schools: 1. Stewart Elementary School – 850 syd, 2. Hollywood Elementary School - 1,000 syd, 3. Roosevelt Elementary School – 950 syd.
