Your firm is invited to submit an offer under seal to Lakeshore Public Schools for new a vinyl tile floor to replace the existing gymnasium floor at Lakeshore Roosevelt Elementary School. The Elementary School is located at 5550 Dennis Street, Stevensville, Michigan, 49127. Bids are due before 2:00 p.m. local time. Deliver bids to the Central Business Office located at the High School. Project Description: The work shall consist of removing approximately 4,820 s.f. of existing vinyl composition tile in the gymnasium and allowing the concrete slab to air dry for a period of 28 days. Begin installing new vinyl composition field tile with basketball court inset tile lines by July 17, 2007.
