The Owner will receive sealed bids for the Manistee High School, Sports Service Building.

Bids are to be addressed to Manistee Area Public School Board of Education, and will be received **until 2 p.m. local time, Monday, July 2, 2007 at the Manistee Area Public School Administration Office, 550 Maple St., Manistee, Michigan 49660**, at which time and place all bids received will be opened and publicly read aloud for general information. The Owner will not consider or accept a bid received after the date and time specified for bid submission.

The work generally includes: construction of masonry bearing walls, wood roof trusses, asphalt shingle roof, concrete flat work, aluminum louvers, steel doors and frames, plumbing for multi-stall toilet rooms, electrical, and site work.

Proposals will be received as follows: Lump Sum, Combined Trades.

Plans and Specifications may be purchased from the Architect for a fee of **\$20. per set.**

The proposals shall be submitted on Proposal Forms furnished by the Architect as part of the Contract Documents, and shall be completely executed in strict accordance with the Plans and Specifications. Telegraphic or telephonic bids will NOT be received, accepted or read.

Construction shall commence within 7 days upon notification by the Owner of his intent to award a contract. The project completion date is September 10, 2007.

Surety company bond, in the amount of five percent (5%), must accompany all proposals. No other form of bid security will be accepted.

Successful bidders will be required to furnish surety company performance bond and labor and material bonds, each in the amount of 100% of the bid.

No bid may be withdrawn before the elapse of thirty days (30) after the opening date.

The bid must be accompanied by a sworn and notarized statement disclosing any familial relationship that exists between the owner or any employee of the bidder and any member of the Board or the Superintendent of the District. No bid will be accepted that does not include this sworn and notarized disclosure statement.
