Project Identification

Parchment High School Track Renovation

Scope of Work

Proposals are requested for the construction of the track renovations at Parchment High School, in the Parchment School District in accordance with Drawings, Specifications and other Contract Documents prepared by Parchment School District.

This project consists of furnishing all labor, materials, equipment and services necessary to complete site clearing, earthwork operations, asphalt paving, and resilient surfacing on the running track, track line marking.

Receipt of Bids

10:00 A.M., Local time in effect on January 18, 2008, at the Administration office, Parchment School District, 520 N. Orient, Parchment, Michigan 49004.

Sealed proposals will be received by the Parchment School District up to 10:00 A.M., local time in effect on January 18, 2008, at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud. The envelope containing the bid must be identified on the outside as "Bid for Track Renovation".

Examination and Procurement of Documents

Bid Requirements

A bid bond or a certified check in the amount equal to five percent (5%) of the total amount of the proposal will be required.

The Parchment School District reserves the right to accept any proposal, to reject any and all proposals and to waive any defects in proposals. If award is made, it will be within 30

calendar days of bid opening to the bidder whose proposal is considered to be in the best interest of the Parchment School District.

All bids shall be accompanied by a sworn statement disclosing any familial relationship that exists between the owner(s) or any employee of the bidder and any member of the Board of Education of the School District or the Superintendent of the School District. The Board of Education shall not accept a bid that does not include a sworn and notarized familial relationship disclosure statement.

This project must be completed in conjunction with other projects being done on site during the summer of 2008. Time lines will be coordinated with the District's Construction Manager, CSM.
