

Request to Bid

St. Clair County RESA is requesting Bids for the following:

CNC Lathe

Bid Proposals will be received by St. Clair RESA, 499 Range Road (P.O. Box 1500), Marysville, Michigan 48040, by delivery or mail, to the attention of George Ann Ragel, Director of Finance and Accounting, by 2:00 pm (local time), September 5, 2007. Bids will not be opened, considered, or accepted after September 5, 2007, at 2:00 pm.

Proposals must be sealed with Bidder's name on the outside of the envelope and designated as follows:

Bid Proposals shall be on forms as provided on this Web Page.

Bidder is required to include all applicable taxes (ie- state sales tax and/or use taxes, etc.) and freight in its Bid Proposal.

Bid Proposals will be publicly opened and read aloud at 2:30 pm on, September 5, 2007. These proposals will be evaluated with recommended awards subsequently made by the district. The owner shall not open, consider, or accept a Bid Proposal that is received after the date and time specified for bid submission in the advertisement for bids.

The right to reject any or all Bid Proposals, either in whole or in part, or to waive any informalities or irregularities therein is reserved by the owner.

All Bid Proposals shall be accompanied by a sworn notarized statement disclosing any familial relationship that exists between the owners or any employee of the Bidder and any member of the School Board or Superintendent of the Regional Educational Service Agency. Bid Proposals that do not include this sworn and

notarized disclosure statement shall not be accepted.

Contractor Bonding: The contractor shall comply with any and all requirements to secure performance bonds and payment bonds for work performed and materials used in performance of the work as required by Michigan statute and including the following bonding requirements:

- i. Performance Bond 100% contract sum
- ii. Labor Payment Bond 100% total labor costs
- iii. Material Bond 100% of materials cost

All performance, labor and material bonds shall be obtained pursuant to bonding agreement executed with a bonding company licensed to do business in the State of Michigan. All bonding agreements shall include properly executed Power of Attorney documentation.

Indemnification: Contractor shall defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the owner and its constituent districts, their Board of Education, Board members, officers, employees, agents and representatives from and against any and all claims, liabilities, damages, losses, costs, and expenses (including actual attorney's fees and expenses) incurred by any of them as a result of, arising out of, or relating to the acts and/or omissions of Contractor or any employee or agent of contractor pursuant to or in connection with this agreement.
