

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed bids are requested for the re-roofing and repairs for Utica Community Schools.

Bids shall be addressed to the Utica Community Schools, Attention: Mrs. Gene Klida, Secretary, Board of Education, and will be received until 2:00 p.m. local time on January 10, 2007, at the Administration Services Center of Utica Community Schools, (Gibbing Elementary School), 11303 Greendale, Sterling Heights, MI 48312. Bids shall be submitted in separate envelopes and be labeled with the re-roofing and preventative maintenance bid proposal number on the label.

Partial Re-roofing – Bid Proposal B-1477-06 (2 Sites)

Proposal includes one base bid project with additional mandatory alternates for two areas and wall ladders. There will be a second site with another re-roof area that will also be considered a mandatory alternate.

All re-roof areas require licensing for coal tar pitch systems by Koppers, Inc.

Proposals must be accompanied by a certified check or bidders bond payable to Utica Community Schools for a sum not less than five percent (5%) of the amount of the proposal.

Preventative Maintenance – Bid Proposal B-1478-06 (50 Sites)

Proposal must be accompanied by a certified check or bidders bond payable to Utica Community Schools for a sum not less than \$7,500.00 or five (5%) percent of the amount of the proposal.

PERFORMANCE BOND AND LABOR AND MATERIAL PAYMENT BOND

100% Performance Bond and Labor and Material Bonds will be required on any individual project in the amount of \$50,000.00 or more. Costs of bonds shall be included in the Base Proposal.

Bidders with proposals less than \$50,000.00 shall provide evidence of bondability. A separate price for a 100% Performance Bond and Labor and Material Payment Bond shall be provided on the Proposal Form. In this event, the bond cost will be added to the bid amount to determine the Contract price.

PROPOSAL ACCEPTANCE

Bids may be withdrawn up to the time and date of bid opening. After bid opening, bids may not be withdrawn for a period of ninety (90) days thereafter.

TENDERS

The Owner reserves the right to waive any irregularity or informality in bids, to reject any/or all bids (in whole or in part), or to award any Contract to other than the low bidder, should it be deemed in his best interest to do so.

Plans and specifications will be available on and after December 5, 2006, at the pre-bid meeting and thereafter by appointment at the office of the consultant.

There will be a \$75.00 dollar **non-refundable** fee for the bid packages. Payment is to be C.O.D. Checks shall be made out to The Roof Patrol, L.L.C.

Bidders will be able to walk all re-roof projects with the consultant (s), at which time, test cores can be performed. Project walkthroughs will be rescheduled if need be due to inclement weather at the pre-bid meeting.

SALES TAX

The contractor shall pay all sales, consumer use and other similar taxes required by law.

FAMILIAL RELATIONSHIP DISCLOSURE STATEMENT

All bids shall be accompanied by a sworn statement disclosing any familial relationship that exists between the owner(s) or any employee of the bidder and any member of the Board of Education of the School District or the Superintendent of the School District. The Board of Education shall not accept a bid that does not include a sworn and notarized familial relationship disclosure statement.
