As required by State Law (P.A. 232 of 2004), all proposals/bids must be accompanied by a sworn and notarized statement disclosing any familial relationships that exists between the Owner or any employee of the bidder and any member of the Utica Community Schools Board or the Superintendent of the School District. **The Board will not accept a proposal/bid that does not include this sworn and notarized familial disclosure statement.**

A certified check or bank draft payable to Utica Community Schools or a satisfactory bid bond executed by the bidder and a surety company in the amount equal to five percent (5%) of the bid shall be submitted with each bid. The successful bidder will be required to furnish satisfactory performance, labor and material bonds, maintenance bonds and financial statements.

Utica Community Schools reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any irregularities as deemed fit in the best interest of the school system. Proposals shall be good and may not be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) calendar days after receipt of bids.
