



NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Grandville Public Schools, Grandville, Michigan, will receive proposals from qualified contractors for the Middle School Mechanical System Remodel project, located at 3535 Wilson, Grandville, MI.

The Owner will enter into a single contract with the successful Mechanical Contractor, who will be fully responsible for coordination of all required work between all trades.

Note: Where “contractor” is referred to in these specifications, this shall be interpreted to refer to the Mechanical Contractor, unless noted otherwise.

Proposals must be mailed or delivered in person to Grandville Public Schools, 3131 Barrett, Grandville MI, 49418, Attn: Deb Reese. All proposals must be sealed in envelopes, plainly labeled “Middle School Mechanical System Remodel” and must be received prior to 3:00 P.M., local time, on Wednesday, March 21, 2007. This will be a public bid opening at the Grandville Public Schools Administration Offices Board Room located at 3131 Barrett Street, Grandville MI. Evaluation of proposals and award will be at a later date; the successful contractor will receive a letter of intent prior to receipt of contract.

A pre-bid meeting will be held at 3:30 P.M. local time, on Tuesday, March 13, 2007 in the Faculty Lounge at Grandville Middle School.

The Schedule of Work shall be as follows:

All bidders are required to furnish Bid Security in the amount of five (5%) percent of the Base Bid. Form of the security may be a bid bond, certified or cashiers check made payable to Grandville Public Schools. This will be a guarantee that the bidder selected by Grandville Public Schools will furnish the required PLM Bonds; failure to do so could mean forfeiture of the Bid Security.

All bidders must indicate, where shown on the Proposal Form, the cost of Performance and Labor and Material Payment Bonds covering 100% of the value of the Project. Do not include the cost of the Bonds in the Base Bid.



All bids shall be accompanied by a sworn statement disclosing any familial relationship that exists between the owner(s) or any employee of the bidder and any member of the Board of Education of the School District or the Superintendent of the School District. The Board of Education shall not accept a bid that does not include a sworn and notarized familial relationship disclosure statement.

Applicable Michigan use and sales tax apply to this project.

All bidders should note that this project does not require prevailing wages.
