Eligibility Criteria:

- Be admitted to a degree-granting program as an undergraduate or graduate student at Western Michigan University;
- Be a Michigan Resident since July 1, 2007;
- Be a member of the Michigan Army or Air National Guard;
- Meet and maintain satisfactory academic progress at Western Michigan University per financial aid guidelines.

How to apply:

- Apply for admission to a degree-granting program at Western Michigan University;
- Complete a 2008-2009 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and send to the Federal Processor;
- Complete the attached 2008-2009 WMU Michigan Army and Air National Guard Grant Application Form to apply for funds for Summer II, 2008-Summer I, 2009;
- Forward the application form to your Michigan Army or Air National Guard unit representative;
- The unit representative will verify on the application form that you are a member of the Michigan Army or Air National Guard and eligible to receive the grant and forward the application form to the State Education Office;
- The State Education Office will verify the application and forward the completed application form to the Office of Student Financial Aid and Scholarships, Western Michigan University.
- **Deadlines: Applications MUST be received in the Financial Aid Office with Guard certification for Summer II by 07/06/08, Fall by 09/12/08, Spring 01/15/09, summer I by 05/14/09. FAFSA MUST also be on file in the financial aid office by these deadlines.**
- Application is only valid for the term in which it was received and for future terms for which you are enrolled within the specified academic year.
