RESOLUTION HONORING MURDOCK JEMERSON FOR HIS SERVICE TO THE MICHIGAN STATE PARKS AND RECREATION SYSTEM

ADOPTED: June 9, 2011

WHEREAS, Murdock Jemerson served as the chairperson of the 17-member Citizens Committee for Michigan State Parks from January, 2005 through December, 2009; and

WHEREAS, Murdock Jemerson served as the Finance Subcommittee chairperson of the Natural Resources Commission's (NRC) Michigan State Parks Advisory Committee from January, 2010 to present; and

WHEREAS, through his effective leadership and dedicated work by the committee, the goal of planning, recommending and securing legislative approval for a long-term sustainable funding plan for the Michigan state parks and recreation system was achieved with the landmark creation of the "Recreation Passport;" and

WHEREAS, the Recreation Passport provides a new way of funding the Michigan state parks and recreation system, and funding to help maintain and preserve state forest recreation; hiking, biking and skiing trails; state-administered boat launches; historic and cultural sites in state parks; and provides development grants to local communities.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Michigan State Parks Advisory Committee recognizes and honors Murdock Jemerson for his contributions to the Michigan's state parks and recreation system and his efforts to improve the quality of life for all Michigan citizens; and
