

2008 Michigan Wild Turkey Hunt – Spring Season

Spring Turkey hunting licenses may be purchased by any hunter beginning Monday, March 17, at 10 a.m. Hunters may purchase one license from any license agent or online at www.michigan.gov/dnr.

License Availability

To check license availability, go to the webpage noted above. Select the yellow “Hunting and Trapping” button on the left, then “Hunting Applications & Drawings”.

Select “Spring Turkey Leftover License Availability”.

To view a map of all spring turkey hunt areas, please refer to the 2008 spring turkey hunting guide, available online or in printed form.

E-License

To purchase a license, go back to the “Hunting Applications & Drawings” page, or the main DNR home page. Scroll down and select the orange button on the left, “Hunting and Fishing Licenses”. This will take you into the E-License system.

From here you will be prompted through the license purchase process. You will need your Michigan driver license or DNR sportcard number, and will be asked to provide your name, address, birth date, and credit card information.

E-License will display a list of licenses currently available for purchase. You may need to scroll through this list to find the turkey-related items. Just grab the scrollbar immediately to the right of the list and drag down to the Turkey section.

Select the following license item:

266 - Res LO Spring Turkey (Resident Leftover Spring Turkey)

You will then be prompted for the area you wish to hunt in.

Continue through the checkout process. Be sure to print your receipt.

You will receive your hunting license via U.S. mail in 5 – 7 business days.
