Transaction: Purchase of Tax-Reverted Land under Act 123, P.A. 1999
State Forest Land Acquisition
Gladwin Management Unit – Clare County
Land Transaction Case #20110080

Purchase: 17.75 acres more or less – To be purchased from Clare County for a price not to exceed \$80,600.00 as provided by statute. 2010 SEV – \$40,300.00.

Description: Clare County, Redding Township, T19N, R6W, Section 16: Government Lot 2.

Authority: Act 123, P.A. 1999, amended Act 206, P.A. 1893, Section 211.131 of the General Property Tax Act, and Part 21, Act 451 of 1994.

Notice: This item will appear on the Department's June 27, 2011 calendar and is eligible for approval on July 6, 2011.

Comments: The Department is proposing to acquire a parcel under the authority of Act 123, P.A. of 1999. Prior to 1999, the Department had the authority to retain tax-reverted parcels at no cost for natural resource and recreational purposes. Act 123, P.A. of 1999, now grants the Department a first right of refusal to acquire tax-reverted properties by paying fair market value or minimum bid, whichever is greater. This first right of refusal applies to all lands that have been foreclosed upon either by the county or the State under Act 123. The Department also has the option of acquiring the property at auction.

This parcel is located inside the boundary of the Gladwin Management Unit, one-half mile north of Temple. The property contains approximately 2000 feet of Muskegon River frontage. Acquisition will help consolidate the State ownership pattern in this area and the management of adjacent State-owned lands. It will also protect both sides of the meandering river corridor.

The Land Exchange Review Committee approves the use of the Land Exchange Facilitation Fund (LEFF) to purchase Act 123 parcels. Funding for this project is being provided by the LEFF. The LEFF Act authorizes

the Department to sell rights in land and deposit the proceeds into the fund, which is used to acquire replacement property.


Recommendation: That the parcel be approved for purchase with payment to be made from the LEFF, under authority of Part 21, Act 451 of 1994, as amended.









 Land Transaction Case #20110080




Section 16, T19N, R06W, Redding Township
