
## New Deer Management Units

Not seeing the unit you usually hunt on the map or table? In response to last season's EHD outbreak and other factors contributing to changes in deer populations in the southern Lower Peninsula, smaller DMUs have been created in southern Michigan (replacing the large multi-county DMU 486). Antlerless licenses are available for both public and private land in these new DMUs:

- 308 = Barry, Calhoun, and Eaton Counties.
- 311 = Berrien, Cass, and Van Buren Counties.
- 319 = Clinton, Gratiot, Ingham, and Shiawassee Counties.
- 332 = Huron, Sanilac, and Tuscola Counties.
- 339 = Kalamazoo and St. Joseph Counties
- 341 = Kent and Ottawa Counties and those portions of Muskegon County in Zone 3.
- 354 = Mecosta and Montcalm Counties.
- 361 = Newaygo and Oceana Counties and those portions of Muskegon County in Zone 2.

**If Public-Land Licenses are Available:**

- Hunters may apply for a license, for all shaded areas.\*

**If Private-Land Licenses are Available:**

- Hunters may apply for a license.\*
- Hunters don't need to apply; licenses are sold until quota met, starting after completion of the application/drawing period for other units.

Antlerless deer licenses are not available.

\* Any leftover licenses will be available after the drawing, and will be sold over-the-counter until quota met.
