Sale: 4.75 acres

Sale Price: Sale price to be determined at auction.

Description: Crawford County, Beaver Creek Township, T25N, R03W, Section 08

Parcel 1: All that part of the SW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 lying east of I-75

(3 acres); and

Parcel 2: All that part of the SW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 lying west of I-75

and north of the centerline of South Old US-27 (1.75 acres)

PA 240 of 2018: This parcel is north of the Mason-Arenac county line and will result in

a decrease of 4.75 acres of DNR-managed lands.

Authority: Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451,

as amended.

Notice: This item will appear on the Department of Natural Resources

(Department) May 5, 2020 calendar and is eligible for approval on

May 12, 2020.

Acquired: By federal government exchange for tax reverted lands in 1949.

Minerals: Conveyance of mineral rights will be determined at auction.

Comments: The two parcels are relatively small, and their location does not offer

forest or wildlife management opportunity or public recreational

opportunity.

The proposed land disposal was recommended for approval as

surplus by the Land Exchange Review Committee on

February 20, 2020.

Proceeds will be deposited into the Land Exchange Facilitation Fund (LEFF). The LEFF allows the Department to sell rights in land and deposit the proceeds in a fund which can then be used to acquire

replacement property.


