Backcountry Riding Opportunities:

Back country horseback riding is permitted on all State Forest roads open to motor vehicles and on State Forest lands that are not posted closed to horse use. State Forest land closed to horses include all non-equestrian campgrounds, portions of the Bladwin Field Trail Area in Gladwin County, the Lame Duck Foot Access Area in Gladwin and Arenac Counties, and un-improved land within the Pigeon River Country (PRC) Management Unit within Cheboygan, Presque Isle, Otsego and Montmorency Counties.
