

**FO-222.09**

**RESTRICTED AND CLOSED WATERS  
FOR FISHERIES RESEARCH**

Under the authority of sections 41101 through 41105 of Act 451 of the Public Acts of 1994, as amended, being sections 324.41101 through 324.41105 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, the Director of the Department of Natural Resources on October 9, 2008, ordered that for a period of five years the following special research regulations shall be established.

It shall be unlawful to fish in the following waters:

At the Hunt Creek Fisheries Research Station, T29N, R2E, Montmorency County--East Fish, West Fish, and Middle Fish lakes, Fuller Pond, and 2.4 miles of Hunt Creek from the Section Z bulkhead south to the Montmorency-Oscoda County line, and all of Fuller Creek, all in Sections 25, 26, 27, 34, 35 and 36. Total water area is about 45 acres of lakes and 4 miles of stream.

This order is assigned number FO-222.09, and is entitled "Restricted and Closed Waters for Fisheries Research."

This order supersedes the order entitled "Restricted and Closed Waters for Fisheries Research" effective April 1, 2007, and assigned number FO-222.07.

This order shall take effect on April 1, 2009, and shall remain effective through March 31, 2014
