Fish Species

Largemouth Bass

- Season: Saturday before Memorial Day until December 31
- Size limits: 14 inches or larger
- Catch limit: 5 per day
- Bait: flashy lures or rubber worms

Bluegill and Pumpkinseed Sunfish

- Season: open all year
- Size limits: any size
- Catch limit: 25 per day
- Bait: hook and bobber gear with worms or night crawlers

Directions

Located in Gogebic County four miles southwest of the town of Marenisco, Michigan. Larger towns in the area include Ironwood, Michigan 35 miles to the west and Watersmeet, Michigan 35 miles to the east.

From Ironwood travel east on Highway US-2 13 miles and turn right (south) on Dunham Road and travel approximately three miles and turn right (south) FR8100. Travel approximately four and a half miles on FR 8100 to the campground.

From Watersmeet travel west on Highway US-2 for 21 miles to Marenisco and turn left on Fair Avenue and travel for approximately one mile and turn right on M64. Travel approximately five miles on M64 to FR 8100. Turn right on FR 8100 and travel approximately four and a half miles to the campground.
