The first purchase of property was The Lake Michigan Unit in Dec. 1926.

The Lake Macatawa Unit was purchased in 1965 to provide additional camping, access to Lake Macatawa and office/shop/housing for the staff.

Explorer Rangers offer several fun and educational programs throughout the week in the summer.


Biking is another family activity enjoyed by those visiting the park.

Deer, small mammals, and migratory birds along with eagles, hawks and more.




Every fall the fall festival is a big hit with the campers. Pumpkin carving, crafts, games and...




Costumed Candy Collection are a big hit with families.
