Authority

The Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, (NREPA), as amended, authorizes the Director to issue orders to implement land use rules.

Discussion and Background:


The Traverse City State Park was established in 1920 after the State of Michigan received the property as a gift from the Traverse City Chamber of Commerce. It is currently managed and operated as a Michigan state park by the Department's Parks and Recreation Division, pursuant to legislative authority contained within the NREPA.

In accordance with Natural Resources Commission (NRC) Policy No. 2407, *Policy for Naming Department Administered Lands and Facilities*, the NRC proposes to rename the Traverse City State Park, in perpetuity, to the **Keith J. Charters Traverse City State Park**. This recommended amendment will make the name change in section 5.16a of the Land Use Orders of the Director pending NRC action.

This amendment also updates the term "motor vehicle permit" to "Recreation Passport" in accordance with 2010 PA 35.

LAND USE ORDERS OF THE DIRECTOR

Amendment No. 5 of 2011

By authority conferred on the Director of the Department of Natural Resources by Section 504 of Act No. 451 of the Public Acts of 1994, as amended, being section 324.504 of the Michigan Compiled Laws and in accordance with R 299.671 and R 299.922 of the Michigan Administrative Code, the Director of the Department of Natural Resources orders that the following order of the Land Use Orders of the Director shall read as follows:

Order 5.16a Entry, use and occupancy of certain state parks recreation areas and scenic sites, prohibited conduct.

Order 5.16a A person shall not do any of the following:

(1) Enter any of the following state-owned lands with a motor vehicle, unless a valid Michigan state park motor vehicle permit recreation passport has been purchased and affixed to the vehicle windshield in accordance with the printed instructions on the permit:

- (a) Agate falls scenic site, Ontonagon county.
- (b) Algonac SP, St. Clair county.
- (c) Aloha SP, Cheboygan county.
- (d) Bald mountain RA, Oakland county.
- (e) Baraga SP, except off-road recreation vehicles regulated under Part 811 of 1994 PA 451, Baraga county.
- (f) Bass river RA, recreation area lands located in sections 1 and 12, T7N, R15W, in Robinson township; and in sections 7 and 8, T7N, R14W in Allendale township north and west of bass river and SW of grand river, Ottawa county.
- (g) Bay city RA, Bay county.
- (h) Bewabic SP, Iron county.
- (i) Bond falls scenic site, Ontonagon county.
- (j) Brighton RA, Livingston county.
- (k) Brimley SP, Chippewa county.
