Proposal: Leasing of Shooting Ranges  
Bald Mountain Shooting Range Facility – Oakland County  
Island Lake Recreation Area Shooting Range Facility – Livingston County

Description: Bald Mountain Shooting Range Facility, the entrance road, beginning at Kern Road, and 60' either side of the centerline of the entrance road, the entire area lying within the fence, including the parking lot and 50' beyond the fenced area and as designated by the Department. More particularly described as part of Section 24, T4N, R10E, Orion Township, Oakland County.

Island Lake Recreation Area Shooting Range Facility, the entrance road, beginning at Grand River Road, and 60' either side of the centerline of the entrance road, the entire area lying within the fence, including the parking lot and 50' beyond the fenced area and as designated by the Department. More particularly described as part of the NE ¼ Section 1, T1N, R6E, Green Oak Township, Livingston County.

Authority: Act 451, Public Acts of 1994, as amended

Notice: This item will appear on the Department of Natural Resources' (Department) May 26, 2009 Calendar, and is eligible for approval on June 2, 2009.

Comments: The Bald Mountain Shooting Range Facility to be leased is located within the Bald Mountain Recreation Area and the Island Lake Shooting Range Facility to be leased is located within the Island Lake Recreation Area.

The lease will encompass both facilities and will be awarded following an open, competitive bidding process.
