The Inaugural Sinclair Fun Shoot

Put your shooting skills to the test in the first-ever Department of Natural Resources Ortonville Shooting Range “Sinclair Fun Shoot” in memory of Daryl Sinclair, a former Ortonville Shooting Range officer who enjoyed shooting and promoting the shooting sports. The stakes are high ... it's your chance to earn bragging rights as the top shot! Compete in the 100-yard centerfire, the 50-yard rimfire or both. Gather your family and friends and pre-register in person at the shooting range or by phone or e-mail.

Rules:

- ⊙ **Tournament dates: August 14 through October 1**
- ⊙ **This is a six-week tournament with one make-up week. Shooters will shoot only one target for their score per week.**
- ⊙ **Shooters can shoot their score target at any time while the range is open, Thursday through Monday, 10 a.m. until 5 p.m.**
- ⊙ **Score targets will be supplied to the shooters.**
- ⊙ **Five shots per target with one bonus shot for an extra point at a “spot” to be determined later.**
- ⊙ **There are two categories: centerfire at 100 yards and rimfire at 50 yards.**
- ⊙ **There are two age brackets: 15 and younger and 16 and older.**
- ⊙ **Stock firearms only — no custom rifles may be used.**
- ⊙ **Sand bags or rests are allowed.**
- ⊙ **Scopes are allowed. Those who use open sights will be scored the same as those who use a scope on their firearm.**

Scoring:

- ⊙ **DNR range officers will score the targets.**
- ⊙ **Bullet holes on the line will receive the higher score.**
- ⊙ **At the end of each week, the results will be posted at the range.**
