Area is included in nomination for Biodiversity Stewardship Area (BSA)

Stand 30 – Check coding on “Y0” stand.
Revise roads marked for potential closure on map.

Compartment 44

Stand 31 is coded wrong, this is a bog, not a “G” type.
Stand 19 – Check that stand will be planted if natural regeneration fails and add comments “if needed”.

Compartment 51

Discussion about how to handle Kirtland Warbler stands that are future harvests per KW plan. Delay until a decision has been reached by the Management Team on a uniform method.

Stand 8 – Is not an A6 stand, check coding.

Stand 15 – Prescribed burn for opening maintenance. Leave west tip for decking. TMS will look at east 1/3 of stand for herbicide possibility.

Revise roads marked for potential closure on map.

Compartment 164

Stand 56 – Cut to 4” spec, leave jack pine tops, leave all red pine and white pine for seed, plant red pine where jack pine does not regenerate.

Stand 86 – Remove treatment

Need to get a decision on how to handle future KW treatments in plan of work.

Add to close Esmond Road at end of County Road

Additions to Roscommon 2010 Plan of Work

Compartment 131, Stand 3; Compartment 129, Stand 11; Compartment 122, Stand 71; Compartment 102, Stand 181; Compartment 90, Stand 6; Compartment 83, Stand 24; Compartment 59, Stands 222 and 223; Compartment 55, Stand 1; Compartment 54, Stand 2, Compartment 46, Stands 240 and 241

Put a fall and winter spec on Compartment 131 stands 3 and 12 and Compartment 132 stands 101 and 34. Add language that there will be minimal retention in these added areas.

Compartment 129 Stands 101 and 11 – Forester and biologist will visit these stands to decide whether to manage with a final harvest that will convert these stands to oak. Stands visited, and post-review decision is to remove the aspen and keep the oak while marking some good form merchantable red maple for retention.
