

## **FRANK RUSWICK**

Frank Ruswick is the Senior Policy Advisory for the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ). As such, Ruswick advises and provides direction on policy and program issues across the breadth of DEQ responsibilities. His role includes analysis of legislative proposals and representing the Department in legislative negotiations and in discussions with other agencies, governmental units, and private organizations. He facilitates the DEQ Environmental Advisory Council. Ruswick was the primary representative of the DEQ in negotiations leading to passage of water withdrawal legislation in both 2006 and 2008 and continues to provide policy direction for the DEQ's administration of that legislation. Ruswick holds Juris Doctor and Master of Science degrees from the University of Michigan. His undergraduate degree in Political Science is from the University of Wisconsin - Stevens Point.
