Dear Senator McManus and Representative Lahti:

Pursuant to Section 1002, PA 189 of 2010, the Department of Natural Resources and Environment (DNRE) is required to report on amounts appropriated, based on federal pass-through funds received in excess of the original amount appropriated for Grants to communities – federal oil, gas, and timber payments, where additional state matching funds are not required. For fiscal year 2009-2010, \$1,050,894.74 of additional authority was provided to the Grants to communities – federal oil, gas, and timber payments line item, based on federal pass-through revenue received in excess of the original amount appropriated (federal Department of Agriculture authority, based on excess timber pass-through revenue). No state matching funds were required for the additional federal authority, which was provided pursuant to Section 1401, PA 118 of 2009.
