

Salaries, wages, fringes, and retirement	\$381,100
Vehicle and travel services and travel	\$25,200
Contractual services, supplies, and materials	\$44,900
Payments to locals and private groups	\$62,100
Payments to other departments	\$33,000
Miscellaneous	\$2,200
Total Expenditures	\$548,500

A total of \$707,300 was appropriated from the Michigan Non-Game Fish and Wildlife Trust Fund for Fiscal Year 2009-2010. The fund began the fiscal year with an available fund balance of \$252,600 and ended the fiscal year with an available fund balance of \$270,500.
