



## ORTONVILLE OR PONTIAC LAKE SHOOTING RANGES OPEN HOUSE POSTCARD OR EMAIL DRAWING RULES

1. Six (6) drawings will be held on or after December 5, 2011, to award six (6) winners one of six prizes – two (2) Family Tradition Tree Stands, two (2) Canoe Sambar Stag Carver knives and two (2) Shappell DX3000 Shelters.
2. Only one entry per person. Contact information must be provided, including name, address, telephone number, and e-mail (if one exists). Winners must show proof of identity when obtaining their prize.
3. To be eligible to win, participants must submit the Ortonville or Pontiac Lake Shooting Ranges Open House postcard or email received from the Michigan Department of Natural Resources (DNR) to the range officer by December 4, 2011.
4. Participants are eligible to only win one of the six prizes. Postcards or emails must be submitted to the shooting range referenced in the postcard or email.
5. On the drawing date, six (6) Ortonville or Pontiac Lake Shooting Ranges Open House postcards or emails will be randomly selected from the pool of postcards or emails submitted.
6. The prize must be claimed by no later than September 30, 2012. Any federal, state and/or local taxes or other fees or personal expenses are the responsibility of the winner. The Michigan DNR is not responsible for additional taxes that may be due when the winner files tax returns.
7. Open to legal residents of the fifty (50) United States (and D.C.).
8. The following individuals are NOT eligible to participate in the Drawing:
  - a. employees of the Michigan DNR;
  - b. employees of any other person or entity involved in the development, administration, or execution of the program; and
  - c. the immediate family members (parent, child, sibling and/or spouse of each) and/or those living in the same household as persons set forth in items (a) and (b) above.
9. The Michigan DNR may modify any of the Rules at any time with or without notice.
10. The Michigan DNR may terminate the Drawing at any time, with or without notice.
11. Prizes are not redeemable for cash, transferable or assignable for any reason and are not transferable upon death, as part of a domestic relations matter or otherwise by operation of law.
12. The prizes are provided to individuals only. Corporations, associations, including school organizations, or other groups may not participate in the Drawing.
13. All questions or disputes regarding eligibility for the prizes, or a participant's compliance with these Rules will be resolved by the Michigan DNR in its sole discretion.
14. If any provision of these Rules is found to be invalid or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, such provision shall be severed from the remainder of these Rules, which will otherwise remain in full force and effect.
