


# FIREWORKS INFORMATION



## What types of fireworks are prohibited in Michigan State Parks?

Consumer fireworks are prohibited pursuant to Michigan Compiled Laws (MCL) 28.462 (1). Consumer fireworks are aerial fireworks devices designed to produce visible effects by combustion. Common examples include Roman candles, bottle rockets and Black Cats.

## What types of fireworks are okay to use?

Novelty fireworks may still be used and include:

- Toy plastic or paper caps for toy pistols
- Toy pistols, toy cannons, toy canes, toy trick noisemakers and toy guns
- Flitter sparklers in paper tubes
- Toy snakes not containing mercury
- Toy smoke devices



## Fireworks Safety Tips

- Please remember to handle all fireworks safely. Even novelty fireworks can cause serious injury.
- Always supervise children using fireworks.
- Only use fireworks in open areas and extinguish any ground, brush or other fires immediately.
- Pick up all litter and debris from fireworks. Littering is also prohibited in Michigan State Parks.
- Use care with lanterns. While a popular holiday novelty, they can also cause serious burns and can set fires by floating into trees, grass and brush.
