REGULATIONS

Black Lake sturgeon season is February 6 through February 10. However, DNR officials will close the season immediately after the sixth sturgeon is harvested, or at the end of any fishing day if only one fish remains to be harvested.

Anglers unable to register on Friday, February 5 may register the morning of fishing at Black Lake, Zolner Road starting at 7:00 a.m.

There is no minimum size limit on sturgeon.

Sturgeon fishing hours on Black Lake are 8:00 a.m. — 2:00 p.m.

Identification flags must be hung at the entrance to each fishing shanty each day of fishing.

HARVEST

QUOTA—6 lake sturgeon in 2016

Anglers must notify DNR officials on the ice immediately after harvest.

Harvested sturgeon must then be IMMEDIATELY registered at the DNR field trailer on Black Lake, Zolner Road.

Harvested sturgeon should have the sturgeon registration tag wrapped around the tail of the fish.

Registration of fish includes examination of internal fish parts, and a small piece of fin may be removed for DNA analysis.
