


# WATCH LIST: Michigan's Invasive Species

The aquatic invasive species (AIS) on this watch list are priority species that have been identified as immediate and significant threats to Michigan's natural resources. These species either have never been confirmed or have very limited known distribution in the wild in Michigan. Early detection and timely reporting of these species is crucial for increasing the chances of preventing establishment and limiting the negative impacts.
