

East and West Twin Lakes

Northern Lake Huron Management Unit will be surveying East and West Twin Lakes (Montmorency County) this spring and summer in order to estimate the number of walleye in these lakes. Soon after ice-out, our crews will be putting nets in these lakes, and will be clipping the walleye they catch, and will also be putting a jaw tag in each of these walleye. We will also be doing some nighttime electrofishing so we can mark additional walleye. If you catch a walleye with a metal jaw tag, please call us at the Gaylord DNR Operations Service Center at: 989-732-3541 to report the jaw tag number. We will also have a creel clerk on the lakes for most of the summer, interviewing anglers about their fishing trip. If you are approached by our creel clerk this summer for an interview, please provide answers to her questions – this information will help us manage the fish populations in East and West Twin Lakes!
