Participants are asked to bring their own gun and high brass ammo for hunting and target ammo for shooting clays. I would suggest 2 boxes for the target practice and one box for the hunting activity. Previous experience with a firearm is required. Some guns/ammo will be available.


You may also want to bring a water bottle, sunscreen, hat – if the weather is hot that day as you will be out in the field most of the day.

Hunt includes opportunity for 3 pheasants per person, shooting at clays with different scenarios, guides, dogs and lunch.

Directions: Take US 2 in Rapid River (east) approx. 5 miles and turn left (north) on W.5 Road for approx. 1.5 miles. Then turn right on 25.75 Lane.
